Home visits include:

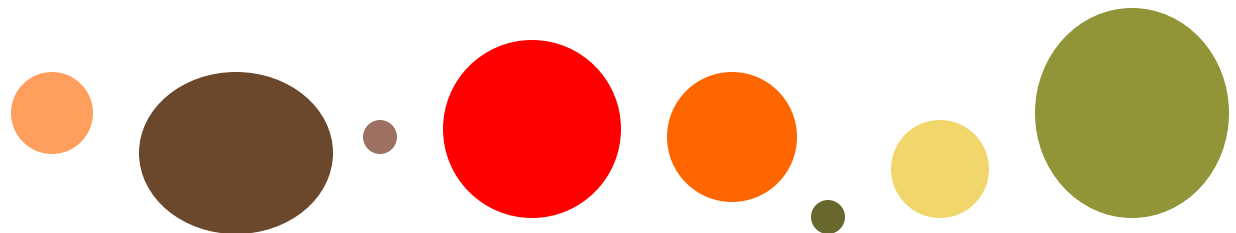
health screenings and education about pregnancy, family planning, nutrition, baby care, growth and development, & other health topics

Public Health Nurses, Community Health Workers, and Social Worker

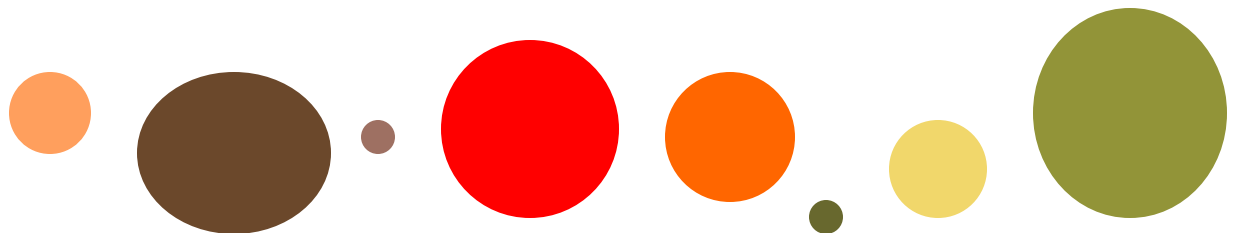
Concentrated efforts to reach:

those identified at high-risk for infant mortality, low birth weight, or developmental delays or disabilities



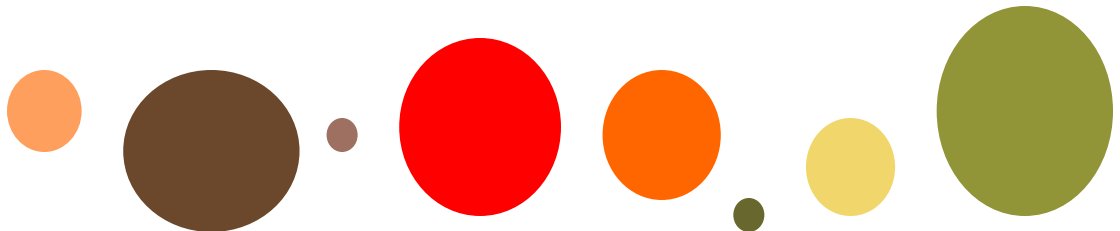
Family Life Team

- Program that offers home visiting services to all identified pregnant and parenting students in the Syracuse City School District schools



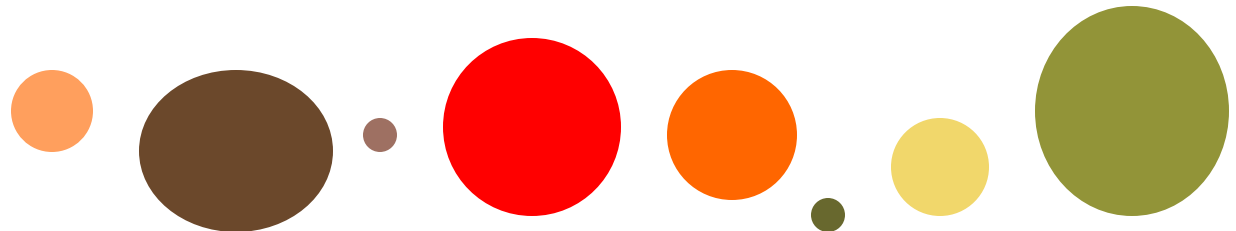
Nurse-Family Partnership

- An intensive evidence based, home visitation program targeting low income first-time moms
- Goals:
 - Improve pregnancy outcomes
 - Improve child health and development
 - Improve parents' economic self-sufficiency
- Any woman can enroll who is pregnant with her first child, meets income requirements, and lives in Onondaga County



Child Immunizations

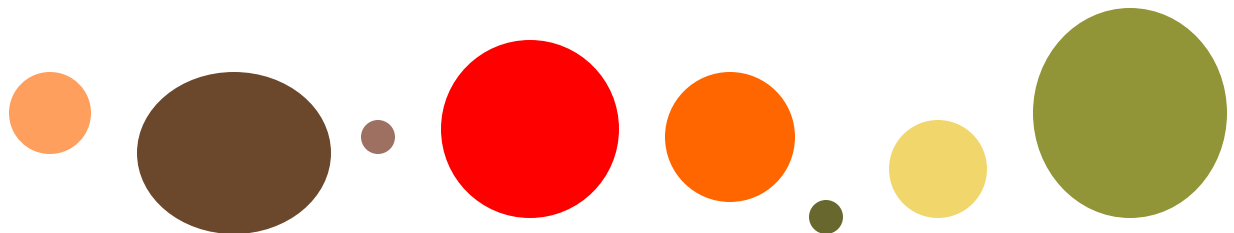
- The Immunization Clinic provides shots to children two months of age and older
- Weekly walk-in clinic primarily targeting children who are underinsured and without a source of medical care
- Vaccines provided to adults over the age of 18 to meet education requirements



Community Health Worker Program



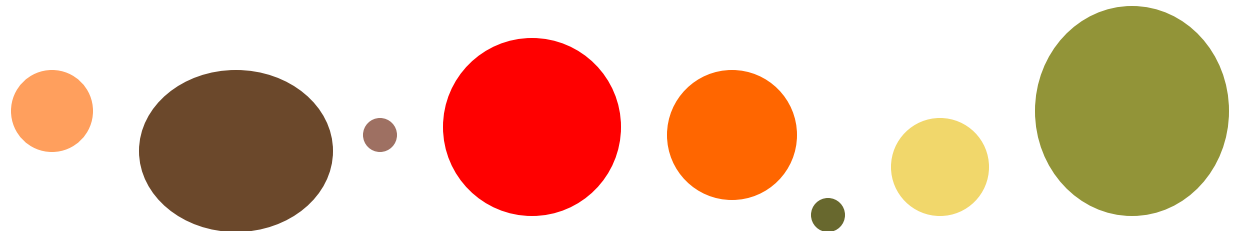
- Provides outreach, case management and advocacy to pregnant and parenting families in Onondaga County
- Target families who are at highest risk to have a baby with a poor birth outcome

Mission:

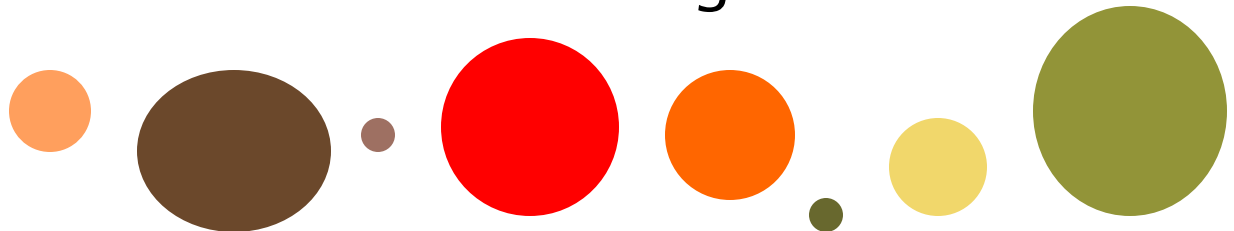
- Improve maternal and child health outcomes
- Reduce racial disparities in prenatal and postpartum health care
- Reduce infant mortality in the City of Syracuse



Syracuse Healthy Start

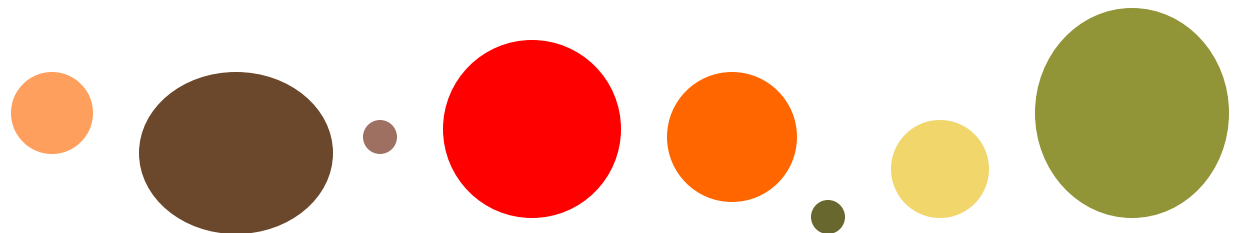


- Serves pregnant women and families with a baby under the age of two who live in the city of Syracuse
- Promotes healthy pregnancies and healthy babies through community partnerships, community referrals, health education, and case management



Syracuse Healthy Start

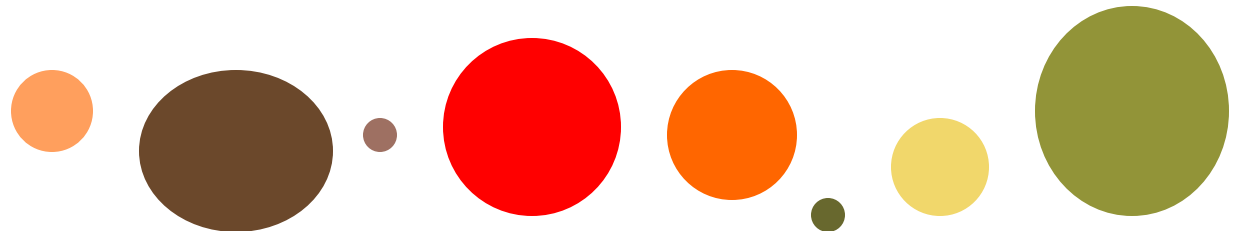
- Case Management
 - Home visitation services for prenatal & postpartum case management services (thru nurse, social work, & outreach workers)
- Community Outreach
 - Consortium
 - Executive Council
 - Neighborhood Outreach Workers
- Health Education
 - One-on-one and community education
- Referrals to other indicated Onondaga County Health Department and community programs



Special Children Services

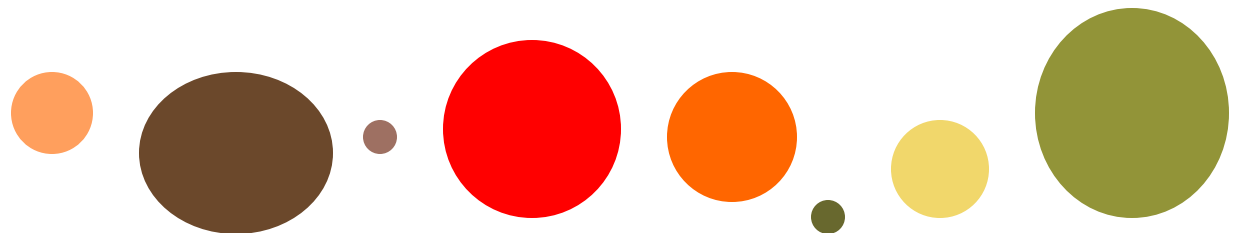


- Provides evaluations, education, and therapy services for children birth to age five who have a developmental delay or disability



Early Intervention Program

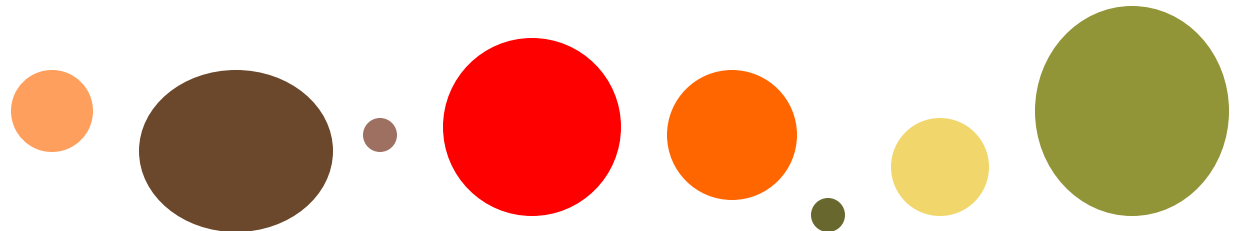
- A family centered program for infants and young children ages birth thru age two years, with developmental delays or who have a diagnosed condition with a high probability of developmental delay
- Eligibility is determined by a multi-disciplinary evaluation and services are based upon the individual child's needs
- Services (direct or consultative) including:
 - Speech, physical and other therapies, child development groups, family counseling, and transportation



Early Intervention C.A.R.E.S

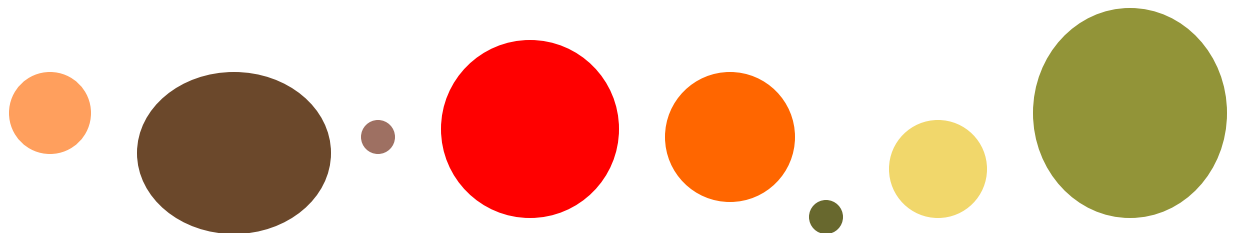
(Children At-Risk Early Screening)

- Is part of a statewide Early Intervention Child Find program
- Identifies children, birth thru two, at risk for developmental delays



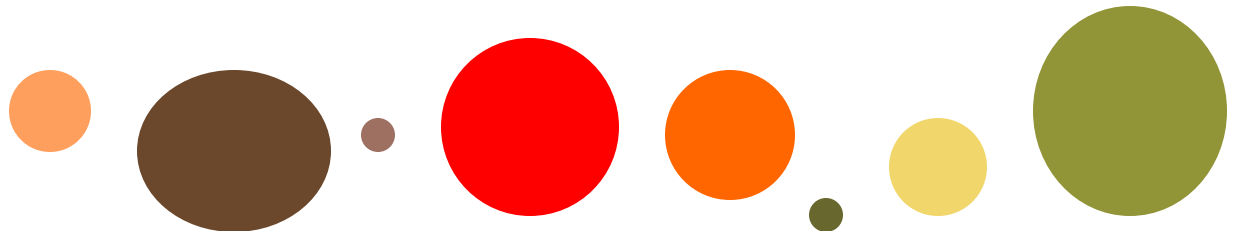
Pre-School Special Education

- Children ages 3 through 5 who have a diagnosed condition or developmental delay
- Eligibility: determined by the special education department in the school district where the child lives



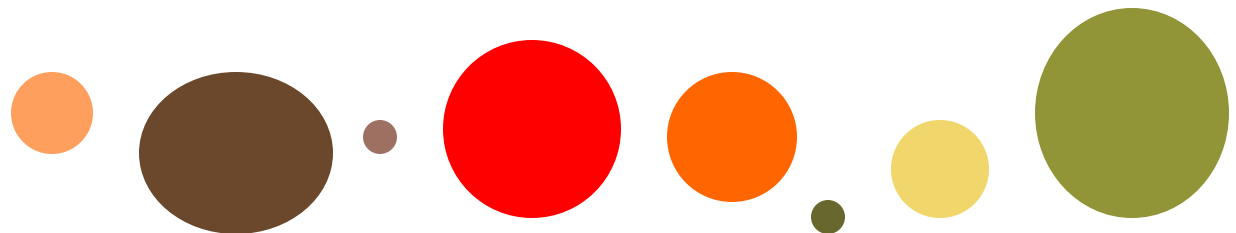
Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)

- Provides checks every month to buy healthy WIC foods & provides ideas on preparing healthy meals for families
- Eligible participants must be:
 - **Pregnant, post-partum** (up to six months after birth of infant or end of pregnancy), **breastfeeding** (up to infant's first birthday), **infants** (up to infant's first birthday), **children** (up to child's fifth birthday)
 - Eligible participants must have an income at or below 185% of U.S. Poverty



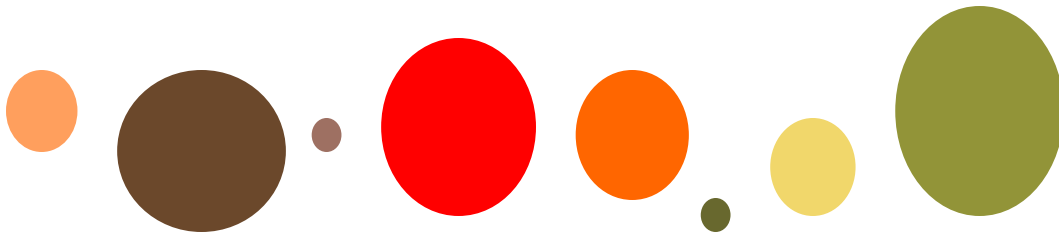
Vendor Management Agency

- Responsible for over 300 vendors (grocery stores) to ensure compliance to WIC regulations
- Covers 14 counties
