

PUBLIC INVITED TO FORUM ON “HOW CNY WORKS”

The Onondaga Citizens League (OCL) continues its current study, “How CNY Works” by inviting the public to participate in the next study session. OCL is examining the diversity of CNY’s economic base. **Today’s session will be held at the Center of Excellence** (directions below), **from 12 – 1:30 p.m. OCL’s study sessions are free and open to the public.**

Study sessions are designed to promote dialogue and learning around critical community issues. This session will take an in-depth look at economic development in CNY – explaining the definition of economic development, how it is measured, who makes it happen, and what can be done to facilitate economic growth.

Leading today’s conversation will be a local economist and representatives from several of Central New York’s primary business and economic development organizations.
