Join us for a fast-moving and interactive look at the businesses and industries that built CNY – and the people who worked in them – as the Onondaga Citizens League kicks off its newest study, "*How CNY Works: Examining the Diversity of Our Economic Base - Past, Present and Future.*" OCL will fittingly hold the first study session at the Salt Museum (Onondaga Lake Park, 106 Lake, Liverpool).

The session will take place on Tuesday, September 27, from 12:00 to 1:30. Several speakers will trace the history of Syracuse's economic growth from its early days on the shores of Onondaga Lake up through the 20th century.

OCL's study sessions are free and open to the public. They are designed to promote dialogue, reflection and learning around critical community issues. The current study will explore the interrelationship between employers, workers, jobs, wages and overall community prosperity, including implications for dealing with the concentration of poverty in Syracuse today.
